CATHEDRAL OF THE SACRED HEART

EASTER TRIDUUM

The Easter Triduum is the apex of the liturgical year in the Catholic Church. What is in time three days is ceremonially one day to portray the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The Paschal Mystery is the central "event" relating to the history of salvation. The work of the Father in the Son through the Holy Spirit is accomplished in the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Mass of the Lord's Supper - 6pm

This evening commemorates the Last Supper of Jesus with the disciples, at which time the Lord instituted the Sacrament of the Eucharist. Because the Eucharist is intimately connected to the priesthood of Jesus Christ, the liturgy also emphasizes Holy Orders. The symbol of the sacrificial service required by the Son of God is the Washing of the Feet. Concluding the ceremony is a Eucharistic procession with Adoration until 12 Midnight.

Good Friday of the Lord's Passion - 3pm

This day of fasting and abstinence marks the solemn recollection of the passion and crucifixion of Jesus Christ. The ceremony begins with the clergy prostrate (lying face down) before the altar. The Passion narrative is read as part of the Liturgy of the Word. A moving moment of this service is the Veneration of the Cross (the genuflection at the crucifix) by all gathered. Mass is not celebrated this day, but communion is offered from the reserved Eucharist.

Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil - 7:30pm

The singular Mass of the day begins outside the church at sunset, where an Easter fire is kindled and the Paschal Candle (representing the Light of Christ) is lit. The service of light is followed by an extended Liturgy of the Word consisting of seven readings of the Old Testament, with corresponding Psalms, an epistle of Paul, and the Gospel which portray the history of salvation. The solemn blessing of the baptismal font precedes the Sacraments of Christian Initiation and the renewal of baptismal promises. The Liturgy of the Eucharist continues as usual.
